

Fees & Billing for Dr Kelly Davis

EFFECTIVE FROM 7th December 2020

Dr Kelly Davis is changing her billing procedure for patients that she sees at Kerrie Road Family Medical Centre. She will **only Bulk Bill patients for appointments that take less than 10 minutes.** For appointments that exceed 10 minutes there will be an **out of pocket fee** applicable to all patients, except for DVA card holders.

The following table is applicable to pension card holders and children only. All other patients will pay the regular practice fees.

If you would like to avoid paying an **out of pocket fee** please keep the appointment to less than 10 minutes. If you have multiple issues to discuss this can be done over a series of appointments that can all be **BULK BILLED** if they are less than 10 minutes.

Kerrie Road Family Medical Centre is a high-quality mixed billing medical practice. Our fees are determined in line with guidelines from the Australian Medical Association and they reflect the level of service that is provided. Consultations and treatments are payable on the day.

We can transmit your claim directly to Medicare via Tyro and the rebate will be paid directly into your account.
