### **Fees & Billing – EFFECTIVE FROM 1<sup>st</sup> August 2022**

Kerrie Road Family Medical Centre is a high-quality mixed billing medical practice. Our fees are determined in line with guidelines from the Australian Medical Association and they reflect the level of service that is provided. Consultations and treatments are payable on the day.

We can transmit your claim directly to Medicare via Tyro and the rebate will be paid directly into your account.

Bulk billing is available for all Aged Pensioners, Department of Social Services Health Care Card Holders and Children under 16 years of age Monday to Friday. *(Except for Dr Kelly Davis – see patient handout)*

**Saturday's and Public Holiday's there is no bulk billing available. Pensioners, HHC holders, and children under 16 years of age will be \$10 out of pocket**

All other patients will have to pay a consultation fee. This fee will vary depending on the length of the consultation and is at the discretion of the doctor.

Veteran's Affairs GOLD Card Holders are always bulk billed.
